




OVERVIEW

This portfolio runs oneday conferences for high school and middle school students on topics in technology. Each day long event consists of guest speakers, a panel, workshops, and a career development session.




COVID-19 RESPONSE

Following the outbreak of COVID-19, Project Tech Conferences cancelled all planned in-person events before September 2020. This resulted in the cancellation of PTC Ottawa's summer conference in Ottawa and the postponement of PTC Waterloo's inaugural conference. With the four remaining months (April through July), the Waterloo and Ottawa committees alternated in hosting free online panel and workshops. Our Kingston team developed a coding challenge that ran during the month of June.

OVERVIEW

This portfolio was established in February of 2020 (7 months in) with plans to pilot events in Ottawa from month 9 onwards. However, due to COVID-19, planning shifted towards online workshops.

In June of 2020 the Outreach portfolio wrapped up all events for Y1 and solidified the structure for the upcoming year, including defining a 4 level outreach event structure and setting up the team structure.





OVERVIEW

On June 1st 2020, PTC launched Issue #0 of "The Array," our first ever newsletter. This monthly publication features three main sections: 'scope,' 'insight,' and 'bulletin.' Each of these sections includes articles on the monthly theme, insight on industry experience, and news on related PTC events respectively.





HACKATHONS

We will be launching our Hackathons portfolio in Y2, starting with an online hackathon open to all regions.

SCHOLARSHIP

Our Scholarship Program is set to launch in the 2022 - 2023 academic year of Y4. This will be a two part annual program with two pools: one designated for students belonging to minorities within the tech industry and another open to all based on academic merit.

CODING CHALLENGE

In the month of June, PTC Kingston launched a coding challenge that was open to all students across Canada (K-12) with a total of 53 participants competing for \$100 in cash prizes, We will continue releasing coding challenges on an annual basis, and its operations will be handed over to the CTO from Y2 onwards.








PARTICIPANT BREAKDOWN


