Our team hosted 2 workshops throughout the year; the first was academicthemed geared towards grade 7-10 students on study tips. The second focused on professional development: a workshop on resume writing!

CODING CHALLENGE

In the third iteration of our coding challenge, we posted weekly questions across July 22 through August 23, 2022 which participants could practice on our challenge platform! In Y4, we are excited to be introducing the coding challenge into our membership programming.

In Y3, we hosted 9 internal workshops for our executive team focusing on soft skills, personal development, and professional development.


PAID OPPORTUNITIES






